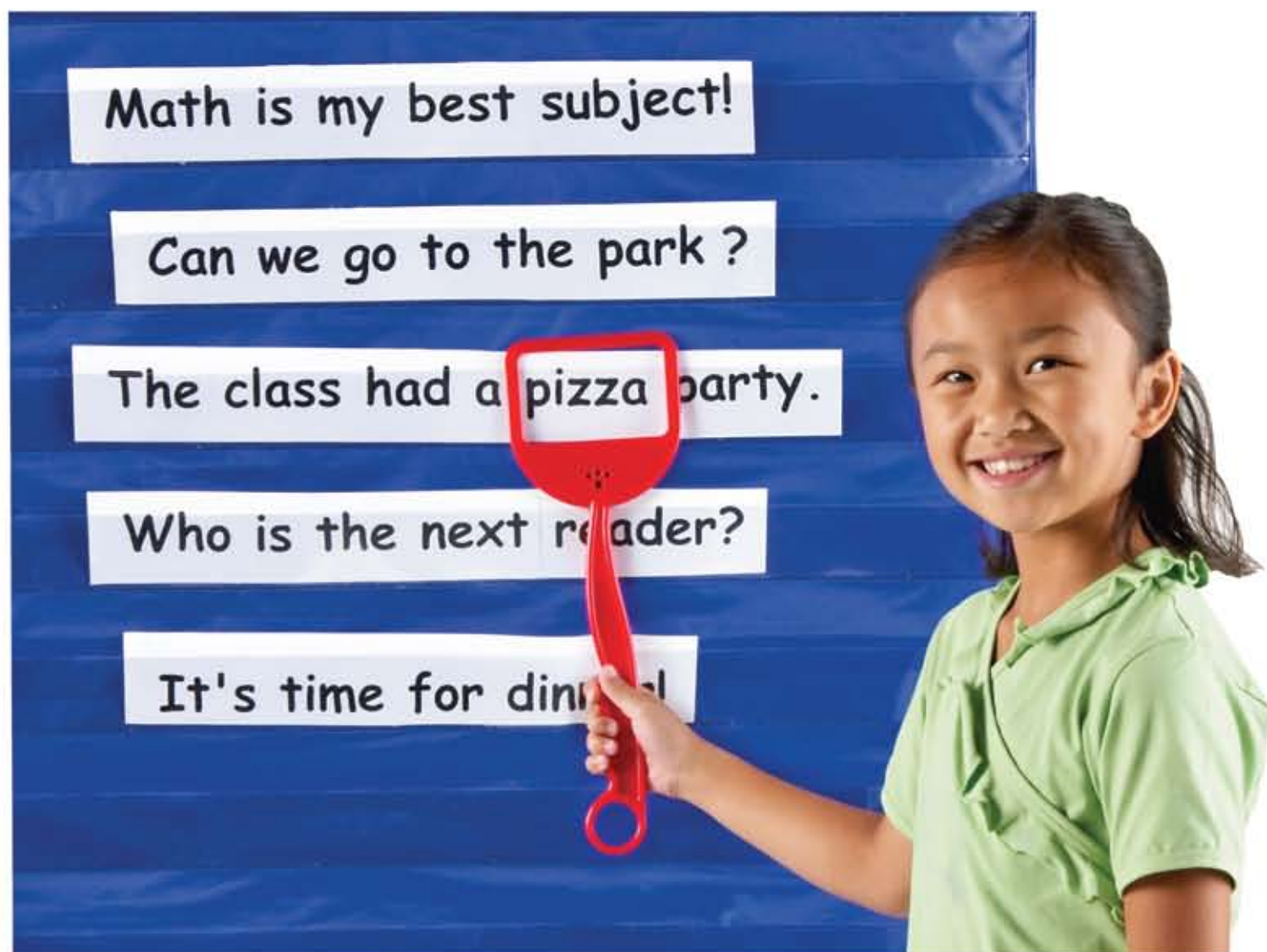

Word Swatters™

Great for the classroom!

- Durable, lightweight swatters come in four colors and sizes for different letters & words.
- Swat a letter or word to make it stand out!



Suggested Activities:

- 1 Write several sentences and place them in a pocket chart or on a board. Ask a student to swat a part of speech, for example, "noun". Students come up to the chart and swat the correct word.
- 2 Write vocabulary words on the board and say a definition. Students swat the correct word.
- 3 Write the alphabet on the board. As a challenge, do not write each letter in alphabetical order. Say a word and have students swat the beginning or ending letter.
- 4 Use only two swatters and divide the class into teams. Use the listed activities as a game. The first person to swat correctly earns a point for their team.
