

Other suggested activities: Each child selects a die to roll. Then, he or she must make a sentence using that word and read the sentence aloud.

Copy the list of sight words listed in this guide. Give one list to each player. The youngest player goes first. Each player picks two dice to roll, says the words aloud, and may cross them off the list. If a "STAR" is rolled, the player may select one word from that die to use. The first player to cross off all of the words wins.

Sight Word Whiz—A game for two or more players using six dice:

- Sentence 1. is, our, the, that, was, what
- Sentence 2. as, or, and, you, she, he, they
- Sentence 3. our, the, is, was, with, her, this, what
- Sentence 4. it, was, we, like, want, go, in, what, is, they, had, she, he, has

Rules:

Side one: Super Sight Word Bingo

Object of the game: The first player to cover three spaces in a row, in any direction, with game markers wins.

Place the sight-word dice in the center. The youngest player goes first, picks one die from the center, and rolls a sight word and reads it aloud. If the player has that word on his card the player may cover it with a game marker and return the die to the center. If he or she rolls a star, the player may choose any one word from that die. If there are no matching words on the player's card, his or her turn is over. Return the die to the center. It is now the next player's turn. Play continues clockwise. The first player that completes one row in any direction wins.

Side two: Roll and Write Sight Words Game (second level of difficulty). Use the write-on/wipe-off crayons and six dice to play this game.

Object of the game: Write sight words in the spaces to complete all four correct sentences or questions on the card.

Place all dice in the center. The youngest player goes first, picks one die from the center, and rolls a sight word and reads it aloud. All players look at their cards to see if that word is a good choice for one, or more, of the spaces on their cards. Players can write it in that space using their write-on/wipe-off crayons. They may use the same word in more than one space.

If a player rolls a star, he or she may choose any one word from that die to fill in a space on the card. Read the word aloud. All players check to see if they can also use that word on their cards.

The player returns the die to the center and it is now the next player's turn. Each player picks a new die from the center to roll. The first person to complete all four sentences reads the sentences aloud. If all sentences are correct, that player is the winner! If any sentence is incorrect, that player must erase the incorrect words and play continues.

Answer Key:

Try any of these sight words to make a correct sentence.

Card A

Sentence 1. are, is, has, he, have, she, they, want, was, what, you

Sentence 2. like, our, his, her, the, want, this, have, that, the

Sentence 3. had, he, is, it, was, she, they, want, what, you, that, we

Sentence 4. has, had, our, that, the, what, and, with

Card B

Sentence 1. want, have, we, they, she, he, has, is, here

Sentence 2. is, was, has, if

Sentence 3. they, had, we, want, are, she, he, has

Sentence 4. the, had, has, is, than, our, was

Card C

Sentence 1. she, he, they, we, with, you

Sentence 2. for, the, that, this

Sentence 3. it, was, we, like, want, go, to, in, is, they, had, she, he, has
