ALPHABET BINGO

Players learn to identify the beginning consonant or vowel in words. Fun facts about the items pictured on the cards are included.

Contents

- 4 Bingo Cards—Bingo game board on the front side; fun facts on reverse.
- Spinner
- 36 Star Markers

Object of the Game

To be the first player to cover three spaces in a row with star markers.

Playing the Game

Each player selects a bingo card. Players may fill their free center space with a star marker. The youngest player begins by spinning the arrow. The player names the letter in the section of the spinner where the arrow stops. All players check their cards to find pictures of objects that begin with the letter called out. Using the gold star markers, players may cover one match per turn.

The spinner is then passed to the next player on the left. Players continue taking turns spinning, and naming letters. The first player to cover three spaces in a row, in any direction, wins!
